## MEASUREMENTS

Bear: approx. 12 cm (5 in)

## TOOLS AND MATERIALS

Ricorumi dk
Shade 002 (cream) 25 g
Shade 050 (fir green) 25 g
Shade 028 (red) 25 g
Shade 041 (mint) 25 g
Shade 060 (black) rest for embroidery
Ricorumi Lamé
Shade 001 (silver) 10 g
Rico crochet hook 2.5 mm
Rico embroidery needle
Rico stitch marker
Rico metal ring, anthracite, 15 cm
Rico synthetic stuffing

## TENSION

26 sts and 24 rows over dc on 3 mm hook
$=10 \times 10 \mathrm{~cm}$

## ARM (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: In cream, working into a magic ring, 6 dc. Do not stuff.
Rnds 2 - 8: 6 dc.
Lay flat and close opening with $2 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st through both layers.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## LEG (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: In cream, working into a magic ring, 8 dc . Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 8 times. 16 sts.
Rnd 3: BLO, 16 dc .
Rnd 4: 16 dc .
Rnd 5: [2 dc, dc2tog] 4 times. 12 sts
Rnd 6: [4 dc, dc2tog] 2 times. 10 sts
Rnd 7: 10 dc .
Rnd 8: [3 dc, dc2tog] 2 times. 8 sts.
Rnds 9 -11: 8 dc
Lay flat and close opening with $3 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{sl}$ st through both layers.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## HEAD

Rnd 1: In cream, working into a magic ring, 6 dc. Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 3: [ $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 4: [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 24 sts. Rnd 5: [ $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st] 6 times. 30 sts. Rnds 6-11: 30 dc .
Rnd 12: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 13: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 14: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.
Fill Head with stuffing.
1 sl st in next st.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## BODY

Rnd 1: In cream, working into a magic ring, 6 dc.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 6 times. 12 sts.
Rnd 3: [ $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 4: [2 dc, 2 dc in next st] 6 times. 24 sts.
Rnd 5: [ $3 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st] 6 times. 30 sts.
Rnd 6: 2 dc , [2 dc in next st, 4 dc ] 5 times, 2 dc in next st, 2 dc. 36 sts
Rnds 7 - 11: 36 dc .
Rnd 12: 2 dc, [dc2tog, 4 dc] 5 times, dc2tog, 2 dc. 30 sts.
Rnd 13: 30 dc .
Rnd 14: [3 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 24 sts
Rnd 15: 24 dc .
Rnd 16: [2 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 18 sts.
Rnd 17: [1 dc, dc2tog] 6 times. 12 sts.
Fill Body with stuffing.
1 sl st in next st.
Fasten off.

## EAR (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: In cream, working into a magic ring, 5 dc. Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 5 times. 10 sts.
Rnds 3-4: 10 dc.
Do not stuff.
1 sl st in next st.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## TAIL (MAKE 2)

Rnd 1: In cream, working into a magic ring, 6 dc. Rnd 2: [1 dc, 2 dc in next st] 3 times. 9 sts.
Rnd 3: 9 dc .
Rnd 4: [1 dc, dc2tog] 3 times. 6 sts.
Lightly fill with stuffing.
1 sl st in next st.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing

## TO MAKE UP

Sew Head to Body, filling neck firmly with stuffing, so that the Head is firmly attached.
Sew Arms to either side of Body on last rnd.
Flatten the base of each Ear in the middle. Sew
Ears to upper part of Head between rnds 3-7. Sew Tail to the Back of the Bear.
In black, embroider eyes and snout as illustrated.

## COLLAR

In mint, make 16 ch + 1 t-ch, turn. 16 sts
Row 1: Beg with 2nd ch from hook, [2 dc in next st] 16 times, 1 t -ch, turn. 32 sts.
Row 2: [ $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st] 16 times, 1 t -ch, turn. 48 sts.
Row 3: 48 dc .
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## STAR (MAKE 2

Rnd 1: In silver, working into a magic ring, 5 dc . 5 sts.
Rnd 2: [2 dc in next st] 5 times. 10 sts.
Rnd 3: [ $1 \mathrm{dc}, 2 \mathrm{dc}$ in next st] 5 times. 15 sts.
Now work the 5 points of the Star as follows.
Rnd 4: *[1 dc, $1 \mathrm{htr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{ch}]$ all in next st, [1 tr,
$1 \mathrm{htr}, 1 \mathrm{dc]}$ all in next st, 1 sl st; rep from * 4 times.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail.
Place 2 Star halves ws together and sew together, using one of the end tails. If desired, fill lightly with stuffing.
Finish seam with a knot, weave in end. Hang Star on metal ring as illustrated with the other end tail.

## HOLLY

LEAF (MAKE 3)
Make $9 \mathrm{ch}+1 \mathrm{t}$-ch, work in a spiral round both sides of chain.
Rnd 1: Beg with 2nd ch from hook, $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{htr}$,
$1 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{dtr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{htr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}, 3 \mathrm{ch}$, cont on other side of chain, $1 \mathrm{dc}, 1 \mathrm{htr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 3 \mathrm{dtr}, 1 \mathrm{tr}, 1 \mathrm{htr}, 1 \mathrm{dc}$.
21 sts.
Close rnd with 1 sl st in next st.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail for sewing.

## BERRY (MAKE 3)

Rnd 1: In red, working into a magic ring, 6 htr. 6 sts.
Close rnd with 1 sl st in next st.
Fasten off, leaving a long tail. With an embroidery needle weave tail through FLO of rnd 1, pull up and secure.

## TO MAKE UP

Place the Bear on one side of ring. Attach one hand to the ring, as if the Bear was holding on to it. Firmly sew folded hand over the ring.
Sew Foot to ring with a few stitches.
Sew Holly Leaves to ring or attach with glue gun.
